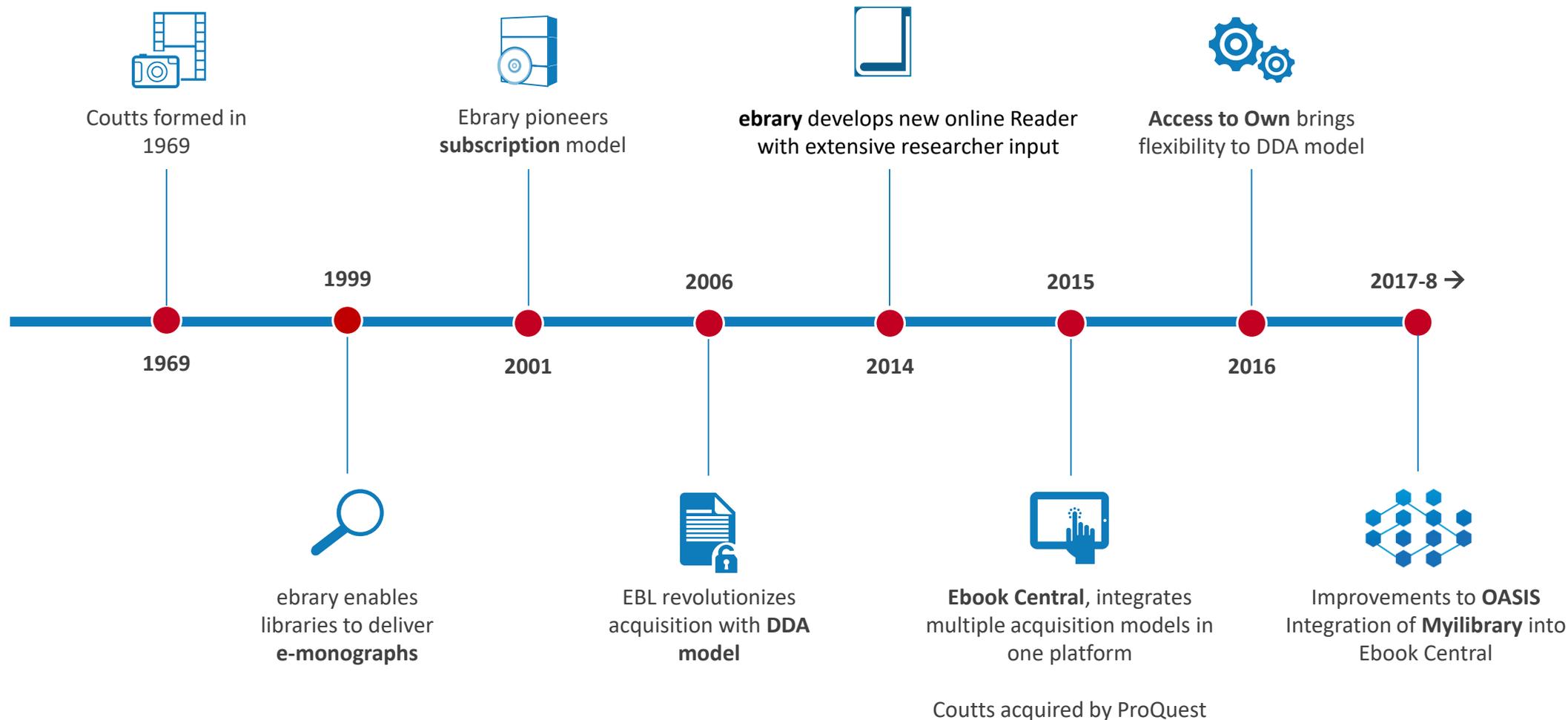

# Ebook Central

...access model pricing options (Perpetual access/DDA)

|---|-------------------|--|
|    | 1-User            | “Digital List Price”, which is set by the publisher                              |
|    | 3-User            | 125% to 150% of “Digital List Price”   |
|    | Non-Linear Access | Varies between publishers, often the same as “Digital List Price” (1-user)       |
|  | Unlimited Access  | 150-200% of “Digital List Price” – all subscription titles are Unlimited Access! |
