



Flexible Acquisition Model Options

Perpetual Purchase

(1U: one user, 3U: three user, UU: unlimited user – including UU DRM-free for more than 125,000 eBooks)

DDA (Demand Driven Acquisition)

- For purchase
- For short-term loan (STL)
- For a designated number of STLs, followed by a purchase
- Concurrent Access (also known as Non-Linear Lending model)
- Subscription »


Demand-Driven Acquisition

- a more efficient way of building your eBook collection
- **1.Build a collection** Select titles appropriate for the interests of your patron base—whether you're looking for content from a specific publisher or frontlist titles in a particular subject area done.
- **2.Expose the titles to your patrons** Load the bibliographic records to your catalog. This allows users to discover titles by browsing or searching the library collection.
- **3.Buy only what gets used** A purchase is triggered when a patron:
 - 1. Downloads an e-book title
 - 2. Views an e-book for more than ten minutes
 - 3. Views more than ten pages of an e-book
 - 4. Prints, emails, or copies and pastes a portion of an e-book page



- ECM user creates and activates a DDA collection
- Your institution can continue to add or remove eBooks to the DDA
- Once an eBook is part of an Activated DDA, it becomes visible for patrons to browse on EBSCOhost.







- Through EBSCOhost, patrons can browse the eBooks that are part of the DDA collection.
- · After a patron meets any of the usage criteria, the eBook is purchased for the institution.

More EPUB eBooks and User Choice

- EPUB has become the e-book format of choice
- 600,000+ EBSCO eBooks in EPUB format and growing rapidly (twice as many as other large aggregator)
- Provide both EPUB & PDF where available from publisher
- Make EPUB available both offline and online
 - Online availability is unique to EBSCO amongst major aggregators
 - Online availability allows EBSCO to offer e-books online from EPUBonly publishers that other aggregators cannot offer

Smartphone Optimization

- EBSCOhost is now fully responsive across all devices
- Users can easily read eBooks on their smartphone
- No need to download the entire eBook
- No need for an app
- No need for a separate account / login
- No need for an Adobe ID

Google Authentication

- Library must have Personal User Authentication enabled in EBSCOadmin™
- User must be institutionally authenticated (e.g., IP authenticated on campus) to create a Google Authentication account; thereafter, user can authenticate from anywhere with Google credentials
- With Google Authentication, users no longer have to log in to My EBSCO*host* to download full eBooks, save favorites, and save notes
